Dear Parents,

Welcome to our new Spring Term! This newsletter provides some information about the learning in Cygnet Class this term which we hope you will find useful.

'Superheroes and People Who Help Us' is our topic until the half-term break, followed by 'Space and Transport' in Spring Term 2. These topics enable the learning to be relevant and exciting for the foundation stage children and knowledge and skills are taught through these themes whenever possible.

This term the children will continue with, consolidate and extend the learning that has taken place since September. The following points outline this in each area of learning.

This term we will be learning to...

English

recognise and recall phase 2 and 3 phonic sounds
use phonics sounds to help with reading
form letters correctly
write their own name independently
use sounds for writing

Maths

subitise (recognise quantities without counting) up to 5
recognise and order numbers 1-10 and beyond
name and recognise squares and triangles
order and compare objects by length, height, mass and capacity
accurately use vocabulary associated with time
recognise odd and even numbers
double numbers
write numbers correctly to 10 and then 20
extend mathematical vocabulary

Communication and language

listen to stories and presentations, responding with relevant comments, questions or actions
follow and give instructions and articulate ideas
use an increasingly extended vocabulary
listen to and share ideas with listening partners
ask and answer questions in group discussions
add detail to stories and explanations

Personal, social and emotional development

include others in games and activities
take turns and share toys and equipment
know what good learning looks like
suggest ideas to solve problems and difficulties

talk about ways we can help each other, both in school and in the wider community

Understanding the world

explore programming a device, translating spoken instructions to programmed instructions
confidently navigate a programme on the iPads and follow and give instructions
recognise the signs of winter & spring

Expressive art and design

find the pulse of music in different ways
sing songs with actions
create own sounds, improvising and composing with voices and/or instruments
identify different textures, feelings and colours
recognise whether a piece of art is abstract or figurative and talk about it
create pictures and patterns after making a considered selection from a wide variety of materials
use tools such as scissors, glue spreaders, tape dispensers and joining techniques competently
use role play to explore different places and people

Physical development

use fundamental physical skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and travelling.
hold a pencil properly when writing
show good control and coordination with both fine and gross motor skills

RE

know about Jesus, the miracles he performed and the messages he gave from his stories
know about Easter and why we celebrate it

Reading in school

We read with the children as a whole class, in small groups and / or individually each week. Every week your child brings home phonics books from our Bug Club scheme and your support in reading with your child every day is invaluable. The phonics books contain sounds that your child already knows or has been introduced to at school and the aim is to be able to read this book fluently and independently. These can also be supplemented by the online books which are allocated to your child. There is story time at the end of each day in Cygnets and the children are becoming very attentive, responsive listeners and are developing the confidence to express their ideas and opinions.

Homework

Thank you for your support with additional homework activities which are allocated each Friday. These will usually consist of a phonics / handwriting activity and a short maths activity which consolidates work covered during the week. We are very pleased that the children evidently work hard on these tasks and take care with presentation, with your support, hopefully having fun with some of the games too!

P.E.

We will continue to have our P.E. lessons on Tuesday and Thursday mornings this term. On these days, please continue to send your child to school wearing their kit which should be named clearly please. Thank you.

The children have made a great start to the year and we will continue to keep you updated weekly via Google Classroom about everything we've been doing. If you wish to talk to us at any time about specific matters, please make contact through the office.
