

KEY INFORMATION FOR THE WEEK

Thank you for taking the time to visit your child's classroom, see their books and speak informally with staff this week. We hope you enjoyed the opportunity to do this.

Success in Sport:

Yesterday our Year 4 children excelled at the Ascot and Maidenhead School Sport Partnership's Primary Dance Festival. This is an annual event celebrating dance with over 750 pupils taking part in 28 performances from 20 primary schools across two days. This time, for the second year running, it was held at Braywick Leisure Centre. The theme this time was 'Kings and Queens' and Teals chose to represent this through an extremely powerful performance reflecting succession struggles. They represented the school superbly and made us all proud. One of our Y6 pupils, Holly Schumacher, also performed over the two days as part of Jane Douglass' Primary Dance Company. Dancers from only 7 schools make up this company so we were thrilled that Holly was there representing Holy Trinity!

Earlier in the week our netball team faced Braywick School in a home match. They were thrilled with a final score of 21-0. They were back in action again yesterday when they travelled to Courthouse Primary School. Our Year 5 team secured a 9-4 win and Year 6 ended the game 18-9 up. Congratulations team!
