## KEY INFORMATION FOR THE WEEK

### Keeping COVID-19 Safe:

I trust the letter emailed out to you on Tuesday was informative and provided a useful reminder of how you can continue to look after your family and support us while we battle against COVID-19. Thank you for the swift action some of you took to help us curb the spread of coronavirus in school. We regularly receive updates from Public Health England which help us to advise you and ensure that measures are in place to mitigate risk. ### Extra-Curricular Activities:

A number of clubs are now up and running with plans in place to introduce more in the coming weeks.
