Industrial Action:

Thank you for your support this week as we have dealt the complexities that industrial action has created. The next day of strike action is scheduled for Thursday 2nd March but plans for managing this have not yet been formulated. Between now and then a number of things might change which could affect how we address the situation. As soon as we are clear on if and how our school will be disrupted, you will be informed.

Book Week – 27th February to 3rd March:

Lots is now in place to ensure our Book Week provides the children with a varied and exciting learning experience. We will be inviting a number of authors to school starting with a visit from Leisa Stewart-Sharpe author of a number of children's books which she has written in conjunction with David Attenborough and his series of BBC Planet programmes. Authors Chris White and Colin Stuart will be in mid-week the children will meet other authors virtually. We have workshops delivered by parents and grandparents and Sarah Parfitt of Partners for Change, Ethiopia will be coming in at the end of the week to talk to the children about schooling in Gende Tesfa and Basso School, when she will give the children a different perspective on the challenges some schools face when books and resources are less readily available. The PTA will be holding a second-hand book sale on World Book Day so do see the flyer for how you can get involved.

In addition, every class will have an opportunity to visit 'The Little Bookshop' in the village. We are incredibly grateful to Chantal who has made this possible for us. The days when each class will be visiting her are as follows:
