We will continue to use Google Classroom this term. Homework will be posted there each week along with messages and photos for the children to enjoy. National Testing Programme:

You may recall my letter which was emailed to you back in September outlining the testing programme which is imposed upon schools by the DfE. (The letter has been sent out today again as an attachment for your convenience.)

Key Stage 2 SATs, taken by Year 6 children nationally, follow a set timetable. However, because an additional bank holiday in honour of the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III will take place on Monday 8 May 2023, the timetable which was initially published has now been revised. Tests will, therefore, be carried out on the following days:

- Tuesday 9 May: English grammar, punctuation and spelling (GPS) papers 1 (questions) and 2 (spelling)
- Wednesday 10 May: English reading paper
- Thursday 11 May: mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)
- Friday 12 May: mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)
